# From the Pastor

#### You Are the Branches\*

[Jesus said] "I am the vine; you are the branches."

– John 15:5

In the last of his "I AM" statements in the gospel of John, Jesus adds a twist: I AM ... YOU ARE.

It's no accident that this I AM statement comes *last* of all – as Jesus is saying *goodbye*, as his disciples face an *unknown* future.

#### Here is both *promise*: "I AM the vine."

#### And possibility: "YOU ARE the branches."

In one breath, Jesus reminds them of the fundamental truth that their life comes from him and their connection to him – and that's not going away, even if it feels like it.

In the next breath, Jesus offers them a framework for *continuing* to experience life together in his absence. They are *connected* to *each other*.

They belong to God – and to one another.

"I AM the vine, YOU ARE the branches." As if to say: It **starts** with me. It **continues** with you – and it only grows stronger in community.

There is *nothing* – neither death, nor resurrection, nor ascension, neither Jesus' absence, nor the disciples' fearfulness – that can prevent them from experiencing the *fullness* of abundant life in relationship with one another.

# There is *nothing* that can prevent them from *belonging*.

In the final poignant moments shared among friends, *mutual dependence* reaffirms a profound truth of what it means to *belong to each other* – a belonging that *not even death* can tear apart.

In the community of the church, *mutual dependence* beckons us, time and time again, back to Christ our vine, around font and table – *and* to the branches that enfold us along the way.

We *belong* to Christ *and* to one another. The vine needs its branches, just as much as the branches need their vine.

We need the vine *and* the branches – a reminder of our rootedness in Christ *and* our connectedness to one another.

*WE ARE* the branches – extending ever outward in welcome, until *all belong*, until *all* come to know this truth:

# There is *nothing* that can prevent *you* from *belonging* – *nothing* that can prevent you from experiencing God's abiding love for you.

Be the branches, dear church.

# **Council Corner**

St. John's congregation council met on **Tuesday**, March 19 for its regular monthly meeting and:

- nominated Mike Centanni and Lindsay Stannard to serve as voting members for the spring assembly of the Hudson Mohawk Conference. (During assembly, only Lindsay ended up being able to attend, along with Pastor Evans.)
- nominated Paula Schwab and Lindsay Stannard to serve as voting members for the annual assembly of the Upstate New York Synod.
- approved new signage designating the chapel building as pet-free (with the exception of trained service animals) in the interest of the health and safety of our members and guests.

St. John's congregation council met on **Tuesday**, **April 23 for its regular monthly meeting** and:

- received a written report from Dan Foster on the status of plans for the new building. At this time, plans are still be drawn up with the aim of a more efficient approval process, as we now know what the town requires from the last time around.
- discussed the need to replace the deteriorating carpeting in the sanctuary. Additional estimates will be obtained for consideration.
- directed the purchase of a gift card for Maggie Anderson in recognition of Administrative Professionals' Day.


